User Agreement

This Clerk of the Circuit Court (“CCC”) Attorney Portal User Agreement (“User Agreement”) must be executed before remote access is granted to the CCC Attorney Portal. The purpose of the User Agreement is to ensure that users are aware of, understand and agree to be bound by the Terms of Use and Conditions and Privacy Policy, and this User Agreement and the responsibilities conferred by both.

You (“User”) certify, by checking “I agree to the Terms and Conditions” check box above, that you have read this CCC Attorney Portal User Agreement, and the CCC Portal’s Terms of Use and Conditions and Privacy Policy, found on the CCC Attorney Portal’s information page, and that you understand and agree to be bound by them.

Reproduction of any portion of the CCC Attorney Portal is prohibited. Permission to use all related graphics and any other material from the CCC Attorney Portal is subject to the Terms of Use, Privacy Policy and User Agreement contained herein.

The User Agrees that s/he is responsible for the following:

1. User certifies that s/he is an attorney with an active license, authorized to practice law in the State of Illinois.
2. User agrees to use the CCC Attorney Portal for its intended purpose, to view court case information through the CCC Attorney Portal.
3. User is not permitted to commercially use the information contained on or in the CCC Attorney Portal or to transfer it to any third party. Any sub-licensing, modifying, publishing, assignment, transfer, sales, or other distribution, text-based, electronic, or other physical or virtual distribution of the information contained on or within the CCC Attorney Portal is prohibited.
4. User may not reverse engineer, translate, port, modify, or make derivative works of the information contained on or within the CCC Attorney Portal.
5. User may not rent, disclose, publish, sell, assign, lease, sub-license or market any of the information contained on or within the CCC Attorney Portal.
6. User may not derive or attempt to derive the source code or structure of all or any portion of the information contained on or within the CCC Attorney Portal by reverse engineering, disassembly or any other means.
7. User may not use the information contained on or within the CCC Attorney Portal to operate an information bureau or business of any kind. The information contained on or within the CCC Attorney Portal may not be modified or merged with other data or software.
8. User may not alter or remove any copyright notice or proprietary legend contained on or within the CCC Attorney Portal.
9. User shall access and use court case information provided and contained on or within the CCC Attorney Portal for purposes related to the practice of law in the State of Illinois. The User shall not access or use court data contained on or within the CCC Attorney Portal for personal or for non-official use.
10. User shall not share or make available login nor password information to any party other than the User.
11. User shall notify the Clerk’s Office in the event the User’s license to practice law in the State of Illinois is suspended, revoked or is otherwise inactive, or if the User’s duties no longer require remote access to court data contained on or within the CCC Attorney Portal.
12. User understands that the CCC Attorney Portal is strictly for the use of Illinois licensed attorneys and that violation of any material terms of the CCC Attorney Portal User Agreement will result in suspension or termination of access to the CCC Attorney Portal and may subject the User to civil and/or criminal liability.
