Tinley Park, IL – The Honorable Dorothy Brown, Clerk of the Circuit Court of Cook County, attended the Abby Foundation's 25th anniversary "Women Together" luncheon held in Tinley Park, IL, on Friday, August 13, 2010. Since its establishment in 1985, the Abby Foundation's membership has grown from its original 20 members to almost 100. The mission of the Abby Foundation is to continue to raise finances to aid nonprofit organizations that deal with domestic violence prevention and breast cancer awareness.

Located in Chicago's south suburbs, the Abby Foundation has given more than \$1 million in grants to nonprofit organizations and through athletic and academic excellence scholarships for women.
